



Northern Right Whale Coloring Contest

The Endangered Northern Right is a baleen whale - 35 to 50+ feet long – up to 100 tons and feeds on krill and copepods. Even after almost 70 years of protected status, the Northern Right Whale is the most endangered of the great whales. With fewer than 450 right whales remaining in the North Atlantic (possibly fewer than 437), and only 100 females of breeding age remaining in the population, time is clearly running out.

Current threats to the species include collisions with ships and entanglement in fishing gear.
