The tour of Arrowhead on Sunday, September 17, will be guided by [Author-in-Residence, Jana Laiz](#), who has published several children's books.

The Itinerary includes a private dinner at the hotel on Saturday, and dinner at the Hancock Shaker Village on Sunday.

Here in Pittsfield, MA, at the very center of the Berkshires, sits the boutique Hotel on North that celebrates character in every way. They've used a modern lens to honor the historic buildings they call home, so while whispers of the past echo through the corridors, the vibrant spirit of the hotel draws its life force from the present.

Those wishing to register will call into the hotel at 413-358-4741, and use the code "Whaling Masters." The rate is \$178/night for each room. Register with

the hotel by July 16 for the DWM discounted rate. The hotel didn't offer a single occupancy rate, but we learned that there are a few single rooms. Incidentally, Noel's great-grandfather served as cabin boy on the *C. W. Morgan*.

Dinner on Saturday will be at 6:30, and choices will include: tomato soup, clam chowder, Caesar or mixed green salad; meatloaf, Faroe Island salmon, roast chicken breast or chef's choice pasta; Mary's carrot cake or flourless chocolate cake.

The Ashley House tells the intertwined stories of the Ashleys and the enslaved African Americans who lived here in the 18th century. Inspired by Revolutionary-era rhetoric and her own desire for freedom, Mum Bett, who was enslaved in the Ashley House, helped end slavery in Massachusetts. In 1781, she sued Col. Ashley for her freedom – and won. Mum Bett was and remains an inspiration to all who learn her story.

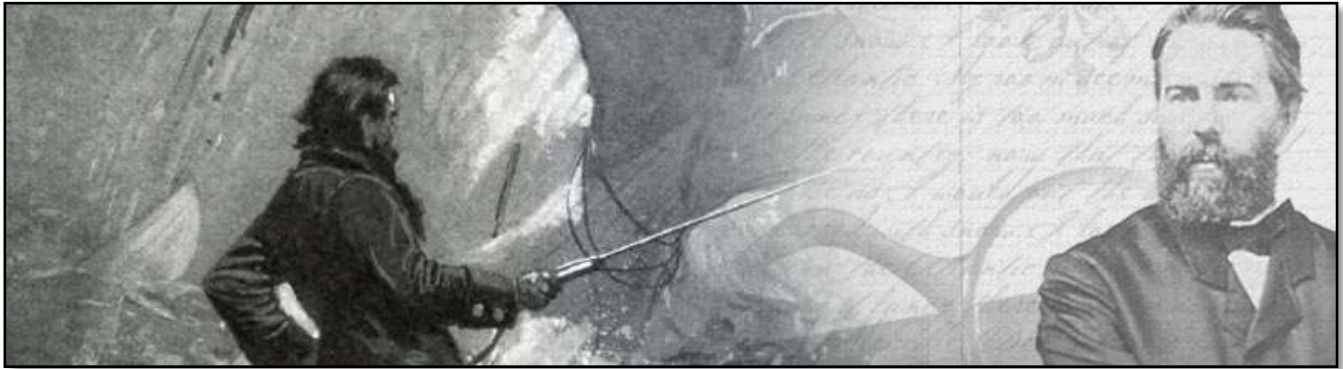
