Restaurant seating in Provincetown is in high demand past September on weekend evenings. We have contacted many of the best restaurants about group dinners, but aside from Fanizzi's, we have met either no response or a blunt rejection. For this reason, guests will need to make their own reservations for Sunday evening, September 29.
